Helpful Resources from City of Chandler

Did you know you can schedule **bulk curbside pickup** for any bulk trash as frequently as every six weeks for **FREE**?! This is a service provided by the City of Chandler to residents.

How to Schedule Bulk Collection:

 Call 480-782-3510 or complete the <u>Bulk Request Form</u>* found on the Chandleraz.gov website

*Advance notice of 7-14 days is required for online requests.

Is there a street light out in the neighborhood? City of Chandler handles all street light repairs for city neighborhoods. To report a street light outage, contact the Street Light Repair Hotline at 480-782-3450, or **report a street light outage online** at chandleraz.gov.

Unsure of how to properly dispose of household items that come with warning labels describing the waste as Toxic, Reactive, Ignitable, or Corrosive? City of Chandler offers a **Household Hazardous Waste disposal service** for residents. All disposal services require an appointment. You can schedule services by calling 480-782-3510. 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House Painting Tips from Dunn Edwards

When considering a house painter, there are many factors to evaluate - which can be daunting. To help, Dunn Edwards offers a step-by-step guide for choosing a paint contractor:

- 1. Prepare a list of exactly the work that needs to be done, including the paint color and gloss level you'd like
- 2. Reach out to contractors to request in estimate in writing. Ensure the following details are covered in the estimate:
 - Painter's contact info & your contact info
 - Specific work to be completed, with products and colors to be used
 - Estimated completion date
 - Total cost of the project, including a break-down of materials and costs
- 3. Ask the contractor for references relevant to the scope of work, and ensure you have references that can go back a few years to evaluate quality of work. Ask the references the following questions:
 - Was the job completed on time
 - Were you satisfied with the results?
 - Did the final cost match the estimate?
 - Was the painter's work disruptive?
 - Would you hire the painter again?
- 4. Ask the contractor for a certificate of insurance
- 5. Check your state contractor licensing laws
- 6. When you've decided on a contractor, secure a contract in writing that includes the full scope of work, including how surfaces will be prepared aind painted, how your property will be protected, exact products to be applied, a schedule for completion, and payment terms.
